Enclosed for your review and approval is the First Amendment for the above referenced project. This amendment will result in adding Three (3) statements required by the EPA in order to receive the EPA Grant Funds.

The purpose of this Meter Replacement Project for Meter Parts is to provide the additional parts necessary to convert the meter size from 5/8" to a 3/4" meter size. The entire project generally consists of replacing the existing meters with new Automated Water Meter Infrastructure (AMI) meters.

Therefore, based on the EPA Federal Grant, I recommend this First Amendment to the Meter Replacement Project for Meter Parts, and Authorize the Mayor to Execute the Agreement, and to begin the new Agreement February 17, 2026.

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH CORE & MAIN LP
FOR THE METER REPLACEMENT PROJECT FOR
METER PARTS ON THE BASIS OF A STIPULATED PRICE
FOR THE CITY OF VICKSBURG, MISSISSIPPI**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to the Agreement is entered into by and between the City of Vicksburg ("Owner" or "City") and Core & Main LP ("Contractor") for the purpose of amending and modifying the Agreement with Core & Main LP for the Meter Replacement Project for Meter Parts on the Basis of a Stipulated Price Agreement dated February 17, 2026 (the "Agreement"). This First Amendment is amended as follows.

- A. American Iron and Steel as it pertains to meeting the requirements of the Federal Build America, Buy America (BABA) Act.
- B. Contracts for more than the Simplified Acquisition Threshold must address administrative, contractual, or legal remedies in instances where contractors violate or breach contract terms, and provide for such sanctions and penalties as appropriate.
- C. All contracts in excess of \$10,000 must address termination for cause and for convenience by the non-Federal entity including the manner by which it will be affected and the basis for settlement.
