Subject: Request for Approval of Lodging Expense - State-Mandated New Chiefs Orientation

Dear Board of Mayor and Aldermen,

I respectfully submit this request for approval of lodging expenses associated with my attendance at the State-Mandated New Chiefs Orientation, scheduled for January 11–16, 2026, in Ridgeland, Mississippi.

Pursuant to Mississippi Code § 45-6-19(1), all Chiefs of Police are required to complete annual executive-level continuing education approved by the Mississippi Board on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Training. Additionally, any newly appointed Chief of Police who has not previously served in that capacity is required to complete forty (40) hours of executive-level continuing education during their first year of service. The New Chiefs Orientation fulfills this statutory requirement and is specifically designed for chiefs appointed within the past year.

Further, Mississippi Code § 45-6-19(4) states that failure to comply with these requirements may result in revocation of a chief's certification by the Mississippi Board on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Training. Such an outcome would directly impact my ability to serve as Chief of Police and could place the City of Vicksburg out of compliance with state law.

The orientation consists of daily sessions beginning promptly at 8:00 a.m. Due to ongoing construction along Interstate 20, which has caused significant and unpredictable traffic delays, I am requesting approval for hotel accommodation in Ridgeland for the duration of the training. Staying locally will help ensure timely attendance at all required sessions and reduce the risk of delays or missed instruction caused by construction-related travel issues.

The requested lodging period is check-in on January 11, 2026, and check-out on January 16, 2026. The total cost of the hotel accommodation is \$820. A copy of the room reservation is attached for your review. Hotel costs associated with this training are reimbursable to the agency upon successful completion of the training. This request is limited to lodging only and is submitted in accordance with customary and reasonable travel practices for required training.

• (1) The chief of police of any state agency, county, municipality, public two-year or four-year college or university and any extension thereof in the State of Misslssippi, and the Pearl River Valley Water Supply District, is required to annually complete twenty (20) hours of executive level continuing education courses which are approved by the MississIppi Board on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Training. Any new chief of police having never previously served in that capacity, is required to complete forty (40) hours of executive level continuing education courses for his first year of service. Such education courses may be provided by an accredited law enforcement academy or by the Mississippi Association of Chiefs of Police.
