

Final Order
RESOLUTION GRANTING EXEMPTION
FROM AD VALOREM TAXES

The **Mayor & Board of Alderman** (governing authority) of **City of Vicksburg** (county/municipality) this day considered the matter of granting exemption from ad valorem taxes, except school district taxes, to **Ergon Asphalt & Emulsions, Inc.**

The governing authority finds that the Department of Revenue has certified that the applicant is eligible for exemption. The authority also finds that the property described in the application constitutes an industrial enterprise as described in Section 27-31-101, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended.

This governing authority does hereby grant ad valorem tax exemption to the above taxpayer for a period of 5 years, beginning **January 1, 2026**, and expiring **December 31, 2030**, on the property described in the application with a total true value of **\$3,656,746**

Therefore the resolution to grant ad valorem tax exemption to the above-named enterprise is hereby approved by **Mayor & Board of Alderman** (governing authority) of **City of Vicksburg** (county/municipality) for a period of 5 years as authorized by Section 27-31-101 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, on this the **3rd day of August 2026**.
