I am proud to join Rust College and Cisco in the execution of our Cybersecurity Training project.

One of the initial activities under this project (which the City manages through a subgrant from Accelerate MS) is the procurement of curriculum and pre-certification testing / examination materials for our trainees. This material is key to the kickoff of our training. Payment for these materials is required by Rust at the time of the order. As such, we are requesting payment in the amount of \$83,880.00 to cover the costs for these materials.

The requested amount covers the required curriculum (\$62,280) and testing/exam (\$21,600) materials. Each cost represents coverage of 24 trainees (12 online, 12 in-class through 30 June 2026) x 3 certifications required by the project (72 total units). The unit cost of the curriculum as quoted by the vendor is \$865/unit. The testing/exam unit cost is \$300/unit. The totals follow accordingly.

Once these procurements have been executed, we will submit appropriate paperwork so that reimbursement can be obtained by the City from CMPDD.
