Contract with ARPA Funding Recipients

Reports shall be submitted to the City quarterly by the 10th of October, January, April, and July of each year until 100% of funds are spent. Failure to report as required will result in a demand for reimbursement.
- 6. The Recipient agrees that it will indemnify and hold the City of Vicksburg harmless from any and all claims that may arise by virtue of this program from recipient, its employees, agents, contractors or customers.
- 7. In the event that any future audit or other governing agency finds that any funds were not spent in accordance with ARPA rules, regulations guidelines, Recipient agrees to reimburse the City for all funds granted upon demand.
