Asphaltic Pavements

The following are the minimum specifications for paving materials to be used by the City of Vicksburg Street Department.

Item 1 - Asphaltic Base Course Material

Asphaltic base course material shall comply with Section S-301, "Plant Mix Bituminous Base Course" of the "Mississippi Standard of Road and Bridge Construction", Latest Edition, published by the Mississippi State Department of Transportation.

Material shall be Type II or Type III (BB-1) as specified on the purchase order.

Item 2 - Asphaltic Base Course Material

Asphaltic base course material shall comply with what is normally considered "Contractors' Specifications". Bidder shall state the specifications of the mix offered in the bid submittal.

Item 3 - Asphaltic Surface Course Material

Asphaltic surface course material shall comply with Section S-403, "Hot Bituminous Pavement" of the "Mississippi Standard Specification for Road and Bridge Construction", Latest Edition, published by the Mississippi State Department of Transportation.

Item 4 - Asphaltic Surface Course Material

Asphaltic surface course material shall comply with what is normally considered "Contractors' Specifications". Bidder shall state the specifications of the mix offered in the bid submittal.

Item 5 - Cold-Mix Asphaltic Surface Course Material

Cold-mix asphaltic surface course material shall comply with what is normally considered "Contractors' Specifications". Bidder shall state the specifications of the mix offered in the bid submittal.

Item 6 - Tack Coat

Tack coat shall comply with Section S-407 "Tack Coat" of the "Mississippi Standard Specification for Road and Bridge Construction", Latest Edition, published by the Mississippi State Department of Transportation.

Terms and Conditions

The specifications, as stated, are minimum requirements and may be exceeded by the bidder. However, no additional consideration shall be given for exceeding the minimum requirements and all bids will be evaluated against the specifications set forth in this bid package. Deviations from the minimum requirements, for the purpose of supplying "equal" items, must be approved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg whose decision shall be final.

All bid prices for delivered items shall be net, FOB destination, with transportation charges prepaid by the vendor.

The bid solicitation is for a supply contract of six (6) months duration.

All items will be ordered on an as needed basis during the life of the contract(s) resulting from this bid process.

No bidder is required to bid on all items. However, the successful bidder(s) shall be determined by item compliance to minimum specification requirements.

Monthly billing shall be by invoices sent to the Purchasing Department, City of Vicksburg, P O Box 150, Vicksburg, MS 39181. The invoices shall list, by delivery: location, quantity and items delivered: unit prices: extended prices: total (monthly) billing; proof of delivery (signature of person accepting delivery): and date of delivery. The number of the purchase order issued to award the supply contract shall appear on each invoice. Correctly executed invoices received on or before the last day of the month will be paid by the tenth day of the following month.
