My name is Jessica J. Lloyd and I am soliciting your permission to organize a "Unity Prayer Walk" for the City of Vicksburg and especially the Locust and farmer street area. I am inviting city and county government officials, first responders, ministries, and community leaders to participate. The walk would be on September 10, 2016 beginning at 9 am. The purpose of this "Unity Prayer Walk" is to charge our community to unify in peace and in love to break down walls of division, poverty, and religion, so that the will of God may be brought forth for the city of Vicksburg. The Unity Prayer Walk on August 27 was a great success and we plan to take prayer to the streets of this city. Ephesians 4:3-4 says to make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. There is only one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called. We plan to take prayer to the neighborhoods of this city street by street. We don't need streets to be blocked but would like to request for police car or sheriff deputy to follow us as we walk on the right side of the street and pray if that is possible. As we walk and pray there will be a shofar blown.

The route will start at the corner of Locust and Main Streets at United Episcopal Church. We will walk along Main Street, turn right onto Adams Street, then the option to turn right onto Randolph Street or right onto Fayette Street on to the end of our walk at the playground on Farmer Street. Once we arrive at the playground we will serve hamburgers, hot dogs, chips, and cold drinks to the community. We will also pass out flyers for Vicksburg native Betty Love's speaking engagement on September 18, 2016 at Jubilee Revival Center here in Vicksburg. We will clean before we leave.

We would like to invite anyone that is available from City Hall, the Courthouse, Vicksburg Police, Vicksburg Fire, and Sheriff Departments to participate.

- 2) Ambulance or Firetruck at the playground while serving the food (because of the possible high temperatures and the possible need to administer first aid)
