**SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS
SOLID WASTE ASSISTANCE GRANT
CITY OF VICKSBURG**

I. Method of Payment

Payments shall be made on a cost-reimbursement basis over the course of the grant. Only the eligible costs of actual charges incurred and paid by the City of Vicksburg (Recipient) will be reimbursed by the MDEQ. No payments will be made by the MDEQ to the Recipient's sub-recipients, vendors, or project administrators. Requests for Payment may be submitted to the MDEQ as costs are incurred. The Recipient shall submit Attachment A, Request for Payment, and additional supporting documentation for verification of service/work performed prior to payment being issued by the MDEQ. All requests for payment related to this grant agreement shall be submitted to the MDEQ no later than forty-five (45) days after the expiration date of the grant agreement after which time, the grant agreement will be considered closed and funds will no longer be available to the Recipient. Funds utilized and/or disbursed under this grant award shall be consistent with the Recipient's approved grant application, incorporated herein by reference. This clause shall supersede Clause 5, Method of Payment of the Standard Terms and Conditions.

II. Memorandum of Agreement

The Recipient shall submit an executed Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) signed by the Recipient and recycling program partners: MIDD-West Industries and Vicksburg-Warren County School District within 90 days of the grant agreement. The MOA shall outline the responsibilities of each party for the use, operation, and maintenance of any and all equipment acquired under the Solid Waste Assistance Grant agreement for the improvement of the City of Vicksburg Recycling Program. In addition to the conditions of the MOA, the Recipient and/or the program partners shall agree to promote the recycling program to City residents through various outreach and education efforts including but not limited to providing information on how to participate in the recycling program, the location of bins and materials accepted, and the economic and environmental benefits of recycling.

III. Local Enforcement Ordinance

In conjunction with the acquisition and installation of security cameras at recycling bin stations, the Recipient shall develop and adopt a local enforcement ordinance or regulation which will define the standards of use for the recycling station bins and any other waste collection unit deemed appropriate for inclusion in the ordinance. The ordinance shall also include an enforcement process and potential penalties for misuse of the recycling bins. Documentation of the adopted ordinance or regulation must be

submitted by the Recipient before reimbursement is requested for costs associated with the purchase of security cameras.

IV. Recordkeeping and Reporting Requirements

The Recipient shall keep and maintain appropriate records for calendar years 2017 and 2018 of the total quantity of recyclables collected each month from recycling drop-off areas and bin stations, portable containers used for local events, and other City sponsored recyclables collection areas in the City as available.

The Recipient shall submit an annual report on or before February 28 for calendar years 2017 and 2018, indicating progress to date including information as may be applicable to the project which would indicate the following:

1. The quantity of recyclables collected for each month of the report year.
2. A description of the public education/outreach efforts conducted by the Recipient and/or the recycling partners during the report year to support the recycling program.
3. A description of how the adoption of a local ordinance by the Recipient in conjunction with the use of security cameras has addressed and/or improved the conditions of the recycling drop-off areas and bin stations.


