
## AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT TO EQUALLY DIVIDE COST OF INSTALLATION OF GRAVITY SEWER LINE DOWN MAXWELL DRIVE

This agreement is by and between The Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg, Mississippi (City) and Ramesch Patel, and the parties agree as follows:

- 1. On November 21, 2016, the parties agreed to equally divide the cost of a gravity sewer line down Maxwell Drive to benefit properties owned by each party at the corner of Maxwell Drive and Berryman Road.
- 2. The parties previously agreed that the City's contractor, Fordice Construction, would construct an 8" gravity sewer line down Maxwell Drive for a cost of \$34,787.00, of which Patel would pay \$17,393.50 plus \$2061.00 for the 16" inch casing and 8" sewer line under the driveway for a total of \$19,454.50.
- 3. Patel did pay \$19,454.50 to The City of Vicksburg in order to have these improvements constructed for the property's use and benefit on or before November 22, 2016.
- 4. It has now been determined by the engineers that it is not necessary to put a casing around the sewer line which results in a savings of \$5,580.00. The change is shown on the attached Exhibit "A". The parties agree to this change and this reduction of cost of the gravity sewer line. The savings should be divided between the parties so the City should refund to Patel \$2,790.00 accordingly.
- 6. Patel desires that the refund check be made to his business:
