

RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE IN-KIND SERVICES

WHEREAS, UNITED WAY. is a 501 (c) (3) non-profit corporation that provides our community numerous social and community service programs; and

WHEREAS, UNITED WAY will have a Day of Caring where various teams provide services to assist the United Way agencies to better serve the community; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 21-17-1(8) of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, this program is eligible for matching funds in support of the program by the City of Vicksburg; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of providing a cash match, the City of Vicksburg finds that it would be beneficial to provide an in-kind match by providing two (2) teams of employees to support the Day of Caring by working at United Way agencies; and,

WHEREAS, United Way has provided proof of match to the City Clerk; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF VICKSBURG, MISSISSIPPI that it finds that the Day of Caring program offered by the UNITED WAY is a program contemplated by Sec. 21-17-1(8) of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, that authorizes the City of Vicksburg to support said program with matching funds;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the in lieu of matching cash funds, the City of Vicksburg will provide in-kind services by providing two (2) teams of employees to work at various United Way agencies on April 27, 2017, the United Way Day of Caring, with a cost not to exceed the amount of matching funds.

This is in response to your request dated Feb. 01, 2016, regarding your tax-exempt status.

IRC Section 6033(j) provides that, if you don't file a required annual information return or notice for three consecutive years, your exempt status will be automatically revoked on the filing due date of the third required return or notice.
