## **National Preservation Month**

**Whereas**, local historic preservation is an effective tool for revitalizing neighborhoods, fostering local pride and maintaining community character while enhancing livability; and

**Whereas**, historic preservation is relevant for communities across the nation, both urban and rural, and for Americans of all ages, all walks of life and all ethnic backgrounds; and

**Whereas**, this year's theme, "This Place Matters" encourages citizens to identify, celebrate and help to preserve places that are important to them – then work to save them and celebrate their vital role in our community; and

Whereas, Vicksburg has many "Places that Matter" in our National Historic Landmark district; and

Whereas, many Vicksburg residents, groups, and organizations, work hard to preserve Vicksburg's past for future generations; and

**Whereas,** it is important to celebrate the role of history in our lives and the contributions made by Vicksburg Main Street, City of Vicksburg, Vicksburg Convention and Visitors Bureau, Vicksburg Foundation for Historic Preservation, Vicksburg Heritage Guild and many dedicated individuals in helping to preserve the tangible aspects of the heritage that has shaped our Vicksburg community; and

Whereas, the success of Vicksburg's downtown is largely due to historic preservation; and

**Whereas,** groups such as Vicksburg Main Street, City of Vicksburg, Vicksburg Convention and Visitors Bureau, Vicksburg Foundation for Historic Preservation play a large part in the success of our downtown area.
