Weigh-ins should be completed by 4:30 PM. We are currently anticipating 30 plus boats at this event. Mississippi Catfish Trail 2017

I would like to take this opportunity to introduce to you the inaugural Mississippi Catfish Trail for 2017. It will consist of 5 tournaments and we expect it to grow with more tournaments added next year. The first tournament was March 18 on the Tombigbee River in Columbus where there were 18 boats. The other tournaments are scheduled for April 8 on the Yazoo River in Greenwood (rescheduled TBD), April 15 on the Ross Barnett Reservoir in Jackson where there were 14 boats, May13 on Grenada Lake in Grenada we are expecting around 50 boats. This could possibly be the largest catfishing tournament ever in Mississippi. There will also be one in November, the MCT Classic, of which the site has yet to be determined. All of the tournaments are rod and reel only and will feature a point race that will crown someone as the Mississippi Catfish Angler of the Year. As part of the tournaments we will promote conservation through education to protect trophy fish, which are anything over 15 pounds, by releasing them. The dates and locations for the tournament will change from year to year. The top five in points will be entered to fish in the Catfish Weekly National Tournament at Lake of the Ozarks.

Some facts about Mississippi

Over 650,000 Mississippians or 1 in every 4.5, fish and catfish is the most popular with freshwater anglers. Catfish are plentiful in our state and most other states. Mississippi anglers spend over \$200 million every year on fishing equipment alone. Belzoni, Mississippi is recognized as the catfish capital of the world.

Facts about the Trail

A statewide trail has never been established in Mississippi. Since this is the first year of the Mississippi Catfish Trail we expect to operate it as professional as possible. We are anticipating adding more tournaments next year and possibly initiating a Mississippi Catfish Club that will help cover some of the cost of the tournaments such as plaques or trophies. The trail will be a 100% payback with door prizes given away at every tournament.

Your sincere consideration in helping us establish a sound foundation for this event that I anticipate will be around and grow for years to come will be very much appreciated.

- Live well checks 5am No Trailering
- Fishing hours are 6am 3pm
- Back in sight of ramp by 3:30
- 8 Rods in the water / 2 hooks per rod max
- Fishing from boat only
- No fishing within 50 yards of another boat
- · No jugs, trotlines, limb lines, etc.
- Live fish only No foul hooked fish
- We ask all fish over 20# be released
- \$80 entry fee per boat \$20 Big fish optional
