Dear Mayor Flaggs and Board of Alderman,

In regards to the above referenced project, the project has previously been awarded to APAC, MS, Inc. who is currently awaiting a Notice to Proceed to begin work on Halls Ferry Road. After the award of the project, further review by our technical team indicated that due to the intense residential nature of Halls Ferry Road, it is in the best interest of safety to add additional construction traffic signage to the project.

WAGGON

A traffic control plan was included for Halls Ferry Road with the construction plans, however, the signage shown only delineated the extreme ends of the project for through traffic. Our review has recommended further signage to alert all residents and short term visitors to the area of the potential for construction activities which could include lane closures.

While Maintenance of Traffic was bid by the contractor as a Lump Sum, we feel it is contractually correct to reimburse the contractor for these additional signs due to the fact that they were not indicated on the original plan sheet for Halls Ferry Road. In that regard, it is our recommendation that APAC MS, Inc. be awarded a Change Order in the amount of \$7,800.00 for this additional signage.
