# INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF VICKSBURG, MISSISSIPPI AND WARREN COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

## FY2017 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM AWARD

This Agreement is made and entered into this	day of	, 2017 by
and between Warren County, Mississippi, acting b	y and through	its governing body, the
Warren County Board of Supervisors, hereinafter	referred to as	COUNTY, and the City
of Vicksburg, Mississippi, acting by and through i	ts governing b	ody, The Board of
Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg, he	reinafter refer	red to as CITY, both of
Warren County, State of Mississippi, witnesseth:		

**WHEREAS**, this Agreement is made under the authority of Sections 17-31-1 et seq, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended; and

WHEREAS, each governing body, in performing and/or paying for governmental functions, shall make those payments from current revenues legally available to each respective party; and

WHEREAS, the CITY and COUNTY will file a joint application for FY2017 JAG program funds for a total amount of \$20,111.00, of which \$10,056.00 will be used by the CITY and \$10,055.00 will be used by the COUNTY to purchase law enforcement equipment to improve public safety. The CITY will administer the grant on behalf of the CITY and COUNTY; and

WHEREAS, each governing body finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interests of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing parties for the services or functions under this Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the CITY and COUNTY believe it to be in their respective best interests to equally divide the JAG funds.

NOW THEREFORE, the CITY and COUNTY agree as follows:

#### Section 1.

CITY and COUNTY will file a joint application for JAG funds. City will administer the grant funds for both the CITY and COUNTY. CITY agrees to pay COUNTY a total of \$10,055.00 of JAG funds, which is 50% of the grant award.

#### Section 2.

CITY and COUNTY agree to each use their respective shares to purchase law enforcement equipment to improve public safety for the entire community.

#### Section 3.

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against CITY other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the Mississippi Tort Claims Act.

#### Section 4.

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against COUNTY other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the Mississippi Tort Claims Act.

#### Section 5.

Each party to this agreement will be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this Agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other party.

#### Section 6.

The parties to this Agreement do not intend for any third party to obtain a right by virtue of this Agreement.

#### Section 7.

By entering into this Agreement, the parties do not intend to create any obligations express or implied other than those set out herein; further, this Agreement shall not create any rights in any party not a signatory hereto.

### Section 8.

The term of the Interlocal Agreement shall be for a period of one (1) year or for the term of the grant period, whichever is greater. Either party may terminate this agreement by giving sixty (60) days written notice of termination to the other parties.
