Jacob's Ladder is seeking your permission to hold a 5k walk/run/1-mile fun run and after party on Saturday, November 18th, 2017. Attached you will find the requested route. The route will start on Monroe Street, near the Mutual Credit Union employee parking lot, continue on Monroe to Belmont, then to Cherry Street, Chambers, Glenwood Circle, Vicklan, Wilson, Chambers back to Cherry, then from Cherry to Harris, Drummond, Belmont, Washington, then to Crawford and will finish back at the employee parking at Mutual Credit Union on Monroe Street. The after party will be held in the employee parking lot at Mutual Credit Union. There will be amplified music on the lot from 8:00 AM until 11:00 AM.

In addition to our permission to hold a run and after party on Saturday, November 18th, 2017, from 7:00 AM to 11:00 AM, I am requesting the following items to ensure the success of this day.

- We will need from Monroe closed from 7AM-10 AM to accommodate day-of-registration, parking, the walk/run/fun run, the after party, and clean up.
- We will need all streets outlined on the attached route closed while runners/walkers are present.
- In addition to the original route, we will need the area from Monroe Street to Belmont, Washington, and Crawford closed for the Fun Run starting at 9AM. We are requesting this road closure for when runners/walkers are present.
- Before the start of the Turkey Trot, we would love for the Mayor to welcome the guests to his city and thank those in the community for supporting Jacob's Ladder so that we can continue to help our students reach their full potential.

After your prompt response regarding street closures, it is our desire to inform our community of road closures, increased police patrol during the hours of the event, and the number of participants we are expecting by utilizing local radio stations and Channel 23.

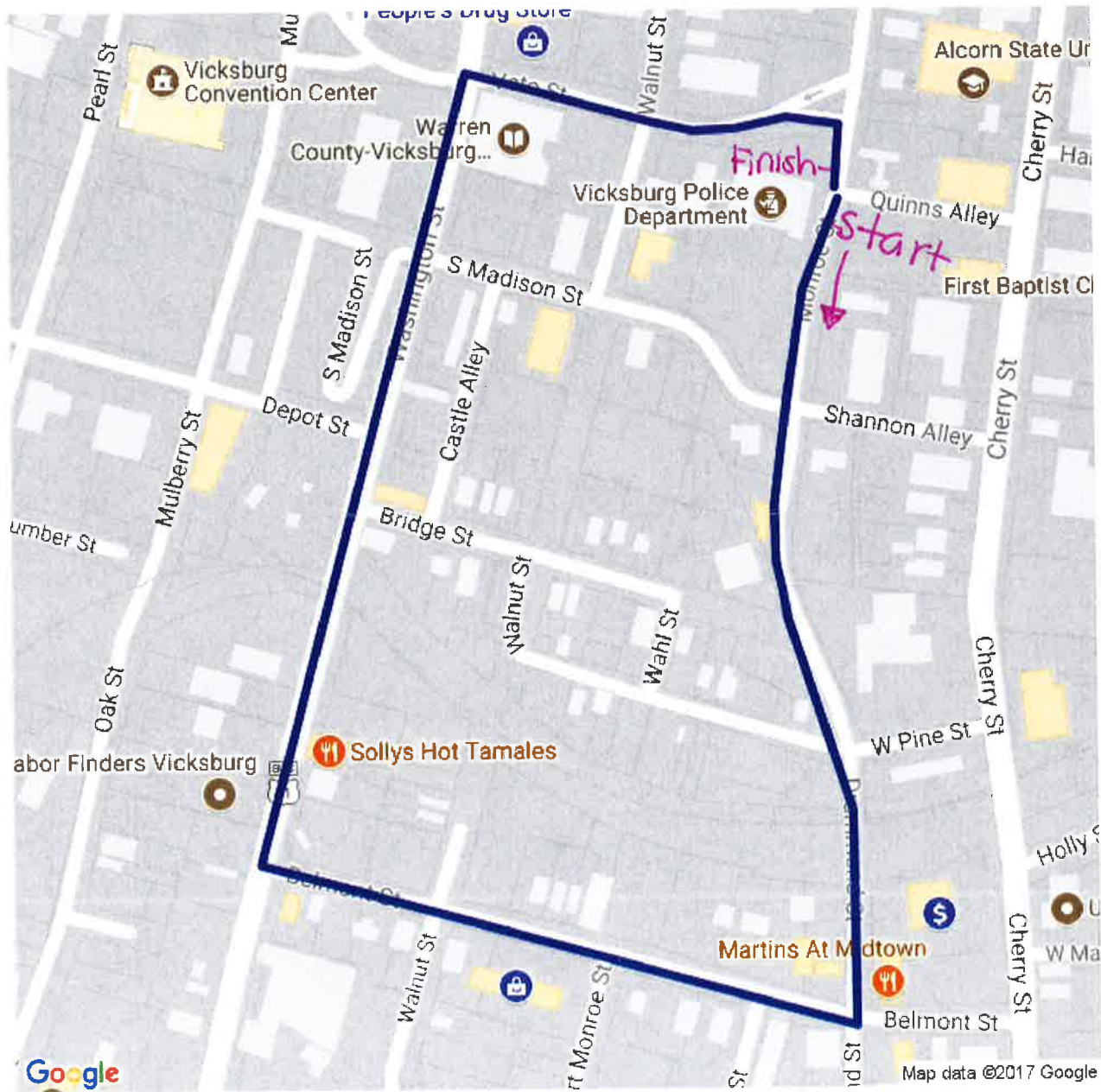
