- 1. The Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg reserve the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive all technical informalities.
- 2. Unit prices will govern over extended prices, unless otherwise stated in notice.
- 3. Prompt payment cash discount, when applicable, shall be taken on all payments made on or before the tenth day of the month following the month in which the items and the correctly executed invoice were received.
- 4. In case of default of contractor, the City reserves the right to purchase any or all items in default in open market, charging contractor with any excessive costs. Should such charge be assessed, no subsequent bids of the defaulting contractor will be considered until the assessed charge has been satisfied.
- 5. All materials and products offered must be guaranteed to meet the requirements of the specification indicated, given, or referred to.
- 6. Prices bid must be based upon payment within the month following the month in which the items and invoices were received.
- 7. The right is reserved for the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg to make an award which is determined to be to the best interest of the City of Vicksburg.
- 8. The right is reserved to reject any bid in which the delivery time is considered sufficient to delay the operation for which the item is intended.

Sand, Gravel and Stone Material

The following are the minimum specifications for sand, gravel and stone material to be used by the City of Vicksburg departments.

Item 1 - Sand

Sand shall be washed, clean, dry concrete sand of no special grading.

Item 2 -- Clay Gravel

Clay gravel shall be a mixture of gravel and clay materials conforming to the requirements of the Mississippi Department of Transportation Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, Section 703.06, Class 5, Group C.

Item 3 - Crushed Aggregate (CR-610)

A. The aggregates shall consist of both fine and coarse fragments of crushed stone, mixed or blended with sand, screenings, or other similar approved materials. The crushed stone shall consist of hard, durable particles or fragments of stone and shall be free from excess flat, elongated, soft or disintegrated pieces, dirt or other objectionable matter.

B. The crushed stone aggregate shall have a percent of wear not more than 50 at 500 revolutions as determined by ASTM C131, Latest Revision.

C. All materials passing the No. 4 mesh (4.75 nun) sieve produces in the crushing operation of stone, shall be incorporated in the base material to the extent permitted by the gradation requirements.

Gradation:

A. The gradation of the crushed material shall meet the requirements of one of the gradations given in Table 1 when tested in accordance with ASTM C117 and C136, Latest Revsion.

- B. The graduations in the table represent the limits which shall determine suitability of aggregate for use from the sources of supply. The final gradations decided on within the limits designated in the table shall be well graded from coarse to fine and shall not vary from the low limit on one sieve to the high limit on the adjacent sieves, or visa versa.
- C. The amount of the fraction of material passing the no. 200 mesh (0.075 mm) sieve shall not exceed one-half the fraction passing the No. 40 (0.45 mm) sieve.
- D. The portion of the filler or binder, including any blended material, passing the No. 40 mesh (0.45 mm) sieve shall have a liquid limit not more than 25 and a plasticity index of not more than 6 when tested in accordance with ASTM D 4318, Latest Revsion.

Item 4 - Rubble Stone Rip Rap

Materials:

General:

Provide 12 inch minimum thickness rubble stone type rip-rap.

Rubble Stone:

Rubble stones shall be hard, dense lime stone or rock, free from cracks and other structural defects. At least 90 percent of stone shall be approximately rectangular in shape, not less than 8 inches wide by 12 inches deep.

Item 5 - Rip Rap 100 # Item 6 - Rip Rap 200 # Item 7 - Rip Rap 300 #

Terms and Conditions

The specifications, as stated, are minimum requirements and may be exceeded by the bidder. However, no additional consideration shall be given for exceeding the minimum requirements and all bids will be evaluated against the specifications set forth in this bid package. Deviations from the minimum requirements, for the purpose of supplying "equal" items, must be approved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg whose decision shall be final.

The bid solicitation is for a supply contract of twelve (12) months duration. At the discretion of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg and with the agreement of the awarded bidder the contract (s) resulting from this bid process may be renewed in whole or in part for an additional year with no increase in cost to the City of Vicksburg.

All items will be ordered on an as needed basis during the life of the contract(s) resulting from this bid process.

No bidder is required to bid on all items. However, the successful bidder(s) shall be determined by item compliance to minimum specification requirements.

Monthly billing shall be by one invoice sent to the Purchasing Department, City of Vicksburg, P O Box 150, Vicksburg, MS 39181-0150. The invoices shall list, by delivery: location, quantity and items delivered: unit prices: extended prices: total (monthly) billing; proof of delivery (signature of person accepting delivery): and date of delivery. The number of the purchase order issued to award the supply contract shall appear on each invoice. Correctly executed invoices received on or before the last day of the month will be paid by the tenth day of the following month.
