Board of Mayor and Aldermen:

Due to the health conditions and age of (K9) X-On, I am requesting that X-On be retired and removed from the Vicksburg Police Department Inventory and Mississippi Homeland Security Inventory. Officer Leonce Young, current handler for K9 X-On, has requested that upon retirement of K9 X-On that Officer Young be allowed to retain X-On to continue providing his care.

Pursuant to Mississippi Code Annotated: § 45-3-52 Retention by Officers of Assigned Dogs Retired From Service

A member of the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol or any other certified law enforcement officer shall be allowed to retain as his personal property any dog assigned to such member when the dog is retired from service.
