PRELIMINARY ORDER
RESOLUTION GRANTING EXEMPTION
FROM AD VALOREM TAXES

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg (governing authority) of Warren County, Mississippi, this day considered the matter of granting exemption from ad valorem taxes, except school district taxes, to Vicksmetal Company.
