Employee Driver's License Policy



The City of Vicksburg requires an employee to possess and maintain a valid State of Mississippi driver's license. It is the employee's responsibility to self-check the validity of his/her driver's license and self-report any negative data, concerning said license, to the Human Resources Department.

If the employee's driver's license becomes invalid after hire, he/she will be granted three (3) business days to rectify the issue. An employee will be allowed to continue to work for three (3) business/working days without a valid driver's license, only if his/her supervisor confirms, in writing, that there are job duties the employee can execute without such a license.

If the employee does not or cannot rectify the invalidity issue, he/she shall be suspended without pay, pending termination, on the fourth (4th) day, upon approval of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen.

Department Heads are responsible for monitoring and Division Heads are responsible enforcing this policy, upon knowledge.
