Dear Mr. Readus:

We are requesting Federal assistance under the provisions of Section 216 of the Flood Control Act of 1950, Public Law 81-516 or Section 403 of the Agricultural Credit Act of 1978, 95-334, to restore damages sustained in Vicksburg, Mississippi by extreme rainfall that occurred during the storm event of February 21-26, 2018. Roads, streams, utilities and structures in our area were adversely impacted as a result of the storm event.

We understand that as sponsors of an Emergency Watershed Protection (EWP) Program project, our responsibilities will include acquiring land rights and potentially any permits needed for construction. We also agree to operate and maintain the proposed measures. We are prepared to provide the local funding and support for the cost of construction work in dollars.
