RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT OPENING OF THE OLD HIGHWAY 80 BRIDGE OVER THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER FOR YEAR ROUND PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE TRAFFIC AND TO ASSIST THE WARREN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND THE VICKSBURG BRIDGE COMMISSION IN ACHIEVING THIS GOAL

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg hereby expresses its strong support for the opening of the Bridge for year round pedestrian and bicycle traffic and hereby offers to assist the Warren County Board of Supervisors and the Vicksburg Bridge Commission of Warren County in achieving this goal.
