Resolution Requesting Local and Private Legislation Authorizing the
City of Vicksburg, Mississippi to enter into lease agreements
For the purpose of waterfront area park improvements and related
Amenities pursuant to Sec. 31-8-1 through 31-8-13 of the Mississippi Code of
1972, as amended

WHEREAS, The City of Vicksburg, Mississippi desires to make improvements to its waterfront on the Yazoo Diversion Canal; and

WHEREAS, Sec. 31-8-1, Acquisition of Public Buildings, Facilities, and Equipment through Rental Contracts does not include public waterfront areas, parks or other amenities; and

WHEREAS, this mechanism of financing improvements to the City of Vicksburg's waterfront would be advantageous for the City of Vicksburg.

Now, Therefore, be it Resolved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Vicksburg that it requests the Mississippi Legislature to enact local and private legislation authorizing the improvement of waterfront area park improvements and related amenities be an authorized purpose for which the City of Vicksburg may utilize the provisions of Section 31-8-1 et seq; and

Be it further resolved that said legislation be adopted to state:

The City of Vicksburg is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into lease agreements with any corporation, partnership, limited partnership, joint venture or individual under which the county or municipality may agree to lease a facility for use by the lessor for the purpose of waterfront area park improvements and related amenities for a primary term not to exceed twenty (20) years. All provisions of Sec. 31-8-5 through Sec. 31-8-13 shall apply to any lease agreement entered into under this provision.
